 Plasma upon your recovery. We do not have access to your test results.
- Are being tested, and you have a negative test result, please celebrate with us by donating lifesaving blood and/or platelets.

What is Convalescent Plasma and How Can it be Used?

Convalescent Plasma is the liquid part of blood that is collected from patients who have recovered from the novel coronavirus disease, COVID-19, caused by the virus SARS-CoV-2. COVID-19 patients develop antibodies in the blood against the virus.

Antibodies are proteins that might help fight the infection. Convalescent plasma is being investigated for the treatment of COVID-19 because there is no approved treatment for this disease and there is some information that suggests it might help some patients recover from COVID-19. (FDA.gov)

As we are all too aware, our community has been hit hard by **COVID-19**. As we continue to see a rise in positive cases in our community, **Cascade Regional Blood Services** is prepared to answer the call to action to service our community in this time of crisis. We have a **dedicated Convalescent Plasma professional** that will be assigned to you to answer all of your questions regarding eligibility to donate, frequency of donations and scheduling appointments.
